

## Photographs and Photography of Team Kennet (TK) Athletes.

- Team Kennet and the UKA are committed to providing a safe environment for children/young people under the age of 18. Essential to this commitment, is to ensure that all necessary steps are taken to protect children/young people from the inappropriate use of their images in resource and media publications, on the internet, and elsewhere.
- At all events, photographers are required to gain permission and register with the host club involved. **This is solely the responsibility of the photographer.**
- Photographs are NOT permitted to be taken of any child (under 18yrs) at any time unless you have gained special permission from the Host Club: parents or guardians must also be in attendance. If permission has been given never use names or addresses of the individual photographed.
- Clubs must take full responsibility themselves if they submit photographs to their own website. (They are advised to gain the relevant permission)
- Outside clubs must gain permission from TK if they wish to submit a photograph containing children/child of under the age of 18yrs old to any other website not associated to TK. This must be submitted through the committee of TK in writing.
- Photographs will only be submitted once all relevant information has been received.
- **Team Kennet's Chairperson, Vice-chairperson, Welfare Officer and any committee member have the right to "step in" if they feel any Photography is being taken without relevant permission or they feel it "inappropriate" at anytime.**

Team Kennet Committee Responsibilities, regarding Photography and Photographers Policy.

- The TK Committee must act accordingly if they receive a complaint regarding the misuse of Photographs on any website.
- TK will call upon a club or persons to explain their reasons if they submit a Photograph containing u18's without gaining the required permission from the club or parent.
- TK will act accordingly to ensure all clubs, parents and associates act within the rules of TK and the UKA.
